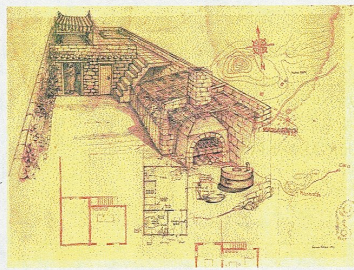


HAVE YOU EVER WONDERED...

1 Canberra design professional and artist Vern Verass has used pen and ink to create this A4 size (8x11") work which shows details of Jesus' Nazareth home. It enables one to capture the family life atmosphere of the era and is a favourite of many who have seen it over the years.

2 Brisbane artist and geo-physicist Dr. Graham Chapman was inspired by Vern's drawing to create a full colour A3 size (11x16") Gouache painting which shows Jesus' home set in the Nazareth landscape with the Sea of Galilee in the background.

Accompaniment to 'THE HOUSE AT NAZARETH'

A note by the artist.

The house shown is depicted on the architectural plans of a hillside in the northern suburbs of Nazareth. It has a steep slope higher on the hill, facing towards the Sea of Galilee with the Nazareth City wall to the right. It is a drawing of what I think the work was made by the artist. Although the walls it might be drawn by measuring walls and by the way many windows, the drawing would have been by the artist's own work. The house is shown in the drawing with the Sea of Galilee in the background. The drawing is a reproduction of architectural plans and is not a drawing of the house as it is, but a drawing of the house as it was in the past.
