PERMISSION-TO-QUOTE POLICY FOR LABORS-OF-LOVE

Urantia Foundation authorizes anyone to quote up to 25,000 words from The Urantia Book in any educational work provided that:

- 1. Standard academic attribution is given to The Urantia Book where it is quoted;
- The following statement of copyright is prominently displayed in the first few pages of the work:

This work uses quotations from *The Urantia Book*, © 1955 Urantia Foundation, 533 Diversey Parkway, Chicago, Illinois 60614; (773) 525-3319; http://www.urantia.org; all rights reserved. The views expressed in this work are those of the author and do not necessarily represent the views of Urantia Foundation or its affiliates.

- 3. The work in question is distributed free of charge by its authors and their agents;
- For every word quoted from The Urantia Book, the work has at least one word that is not quoted from The Urantia Book;
- The work uses no more than 5,000 words in a row from The Urantia Book. If you use up to 5,000 words in a row from The Urantia Book, then you should insert other written materials before using any additional quotations from The Urantia Book; and
- The work does not revise, alter, or amend portions of the inviolate text of the Urantia Book that are quoted in the work.

PERMISSION-TO-COPY POLICY FOR EDUCATIONAL PURPOSES

- For purposes of this policy, "academic" and/or "educational" means "pertaining to institutional classroom teaching or learning."
- Any person may copy and hand out various portions of The Urantia Book amounting up to one full paper of The Urantia Book per each academic or educational use without the necessity of requesting or receiving permission from Urantia Foundation provided that:
 - a. The recipient of the handout(s) containing quoted material is not charged money for the handout(s) over and above the cost of tuition or, in the event of a conference, the fee for attending the conference where the quoted material is handed out;
 - The person copying the material from The Urantia Book does not revise, alter, or amend the inviolate text of The Urantia Book prior to copying and handing out the quoted material; and
 - c. The handout containing the material quoted from The Urantia Book gives the following acknowledgment:

PERMISSION-TO-QUOTE POLICY FOR COMMERCIAL WORKS

- For purposes of this policy, "commercial" is defined as "relating to, or being connected with, the exchange of value, or the buying or selling of any article, goods, or property." Accordingly, a "commercial work" is any work that is bought, sold, or exchanged for value.
- Any person may quote up to 1,000 words from The Urantia Book in any commercial work without the necessity of requesting or receiving permission from Urantia Foundation.
- Any person may quote between 1,001 and 5,000 words from The Urantia Book in any commercial work without the necessity of requesting or receiving permission from Urantia Foundation provided that:
 - a. No more than 1,000 words taken from The Urantia Book are quoted at a time;
 - For every one word quoted from The Urantia Book in a commercial work, the work has at least two words that are not quoted from The Urantia Book;
 - c. The commercial work displays the following acknowledgment:
