Replying to your letter of May 31, you can be sure that the Urantia Foundation is greatly interested in seeing the Urantia Book translated into the modern languages.

In planning for translation there are two important factors: First, financing the undertaking, and second, the organization of a competent group of translators. I am sure the Trustees of the Foundation will always be in readiness to co-operate with any undertaking that promises the realization of these objectives.

The Foundation, I am sure, would not be willing to in any way manipulate the copyright of the Urantia Book and that would not be necessary in making any arrangements for translation. The Foundation will always hold all copyrights.

The Foundation will hold its quarterly meeting within the next two months at which time your letter will be formally presented for their attention.

About the matter of reincarnation, we note your reference to Paragraph 2 on Page 436. Yes, that seems to be the teaching of the Urantia Book. Mortals when leaving this planet embark upon a progressive career. That is, they do not come back during any one dispensation to the planet of their origin. Each change in personality existence is progressive. There is just one instance of reincarnation in all the wide universe. You will find reference to it on Page 528, and it pertains to the spornagia, a type of celestial animal.
