Hello again from a friend.

I wrote 3 or 4 years ago to you for the first time & have visited several times since then. Late spring or summer this year I sent a friend, John Ashburn, to visit & pick up copies of the U book & concordex - He mentioned that one of the ladies there remembered me. I appreciated that greatly... Even if you can't place me right now, your people have always been most kind and helpful to me every time I have contacted you, through letters, a friend or personally. I thank you all heartily!

At this time I again request names or addresses of people in my area that have bought or are interested in the book. I yearn to share faith and companions

that profess faith also. When I had previously requested this I lived in Minneapolis and managed to contact interested people over a period of years. I remember that you wrote back to me at the time saying that there was no national membership as such... But now I have moved to California and am planning to stay a year or so, and I was wondering if there was any change in your policy? I live on the outskirts of a small town c.30 miles Northeast of San Francisco. I have written to Clyde Bedell at his Santa Barbara address thinking perhaps he might be able to put me in contact with some people by letter, if nothing else.

I have a second request - at this time in my life I have chosen to start writing books. I have been a professional musician performing for 6 years, as well as teaching guitar, piano, voice, etc; but I have time during the day to write; a 4 year old child who has read since she was 3; and, mostly, a desire to make the true stories of Jesus in the U book available to her and other children.

I realize fully that one of the main purposes of the Foundation is to keep the U book whole and inviolate. Perhaps you have heard this idea of editing the stories for children before. But I have searched for years and found no book more (over)

full of truth and so desperately needed as this book, and I can think of no greater service I could attempt to perform for the children of this world. The Foundation would of course maintain complete control over exactly what would be included or excluded from the book or books.

I only desire the opportunity to give whatever abilities I could to such a worthwhile project..

After a stay here in California for a time, I plan to move to Virginia Beach, Virginia, to study again at the Edgar Cayce Foundation. Or perhaps to Chicago with the Stelle Group, a community outlined in the paperback book "The Ultima Frontier" by Eklal Kueshana. If Chicago

I is where & more, I will most certainly contact you. In fact, if I felt I could make a substantial contribution to the Urantia Foundation, I would consider moving to Chicago on that premise alone.

My basic motivation in transferring is not only to find the organization that I can put my energies into that will accomplish the most good for the most people; but also a stable long-term community of believers that would provide the best environment for my daughter. I have traveled much in 6 years in search of communities - I have found several. But my time of high mobility is over and I must make a choice soon to stay in a stable community for my daughter's education, for at least a ^{few} decade.
