Dear Jim and friends:

We have now learned from your letter of June 22, 1978, that your Society has now definitely decided not to sign the Licensing Agreement. We know that you have wrestled with this decision over a period of time and that your decision was not an easy one.

The Trustees appreciate your expression of support for the registered marks. We had hoped that you would have been able not only to express your support, but also affirmatively to actualize it with the execution of the Licensing Agreement. Nevertheless, it is your prerogative not to do so, and we respect your attempts to do that which you regard as best for yourselves as well as that which is best for the continued maintenance of the integrity of the registered marks.

Inasmuch as we have not been able to come to an agreement for your Society's continued use of the registered marks, you are by now aware that the law requires that you henceforth make no use of them, including the use of URANTIA as a part of the name of your Society. (While you may no longer designate your group as a URANTIA Society, you may call it a Society for the study of The URANTIA Book.)

Notwithstanding our differing human viewpoints, we wish you and each of your group well.
