The Board has now been able to finalize a preliminary opinion with regard to your suggested Perent's Guide.

I am pleased to report that the Trustees have no philosophic objection to your completing the proposed <u>Parent's Guide</u>, preparing it in form for review by the Trustees.

In conjunction with this, I have been asked to mention that should approval ultimately be given, the Board would probably not be interested in publishing the <u>Parent's Guide</u>, but publishing by the URANTIA Foundation is not to be ruled out at this time.

Also, any final approval would contemplate an appropriate agreement between you and the foundation dealing with such matters as marketing, advertising, copyright protection, possible royalty. In any event, for the moment, please know that we have no objection to the completion of the proposed Papagin Guide, though we don't wish this communication of "no objection" to be interpreted as any commitment for permission to publish in the future. We will need to consider that separate issue in the future when we shall have the final product for review.
