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We hope you realize that these conditions on the grant of permission are the safeguards that we are developing in consultation with our attorneys, and in accordance with our best judgement, to ensure that we are doing what is necessary to carry out our trust of protecting this copyright.

From the list of conditions, you can see that we have decided not to have you sell the puzzles for a profit. Although we appreciate your generous offer, we are not yet ready to set up the mechanisms necessary. We are audited each year to show that we are responsibly carrying out our duties as Trustees. This means agreements, accounting procedures and reporting procedures would have to be developed which is more work for us and for you. Although some interest has been shown in the various secondary works we have given copyright permission for, none have been big sellers. Thus, it seems premature to go to the expense of having attorneys and accountants set up the necessary procedures and agreements. If your crossword or another secondary work is well-received and there is a large demand, we can always reevaluate the situation.
