Dear Neal:

We can't believe that four months have passed since your visit. We trust things are going well with you.

We greatly enjoyed the evening we spent together listening to your views and estimates of the direction of events in China, political, social, and spiritual. Some of the obstacles to the spread of new truth that you describe are formidable but certainly over a long period of time change will slowly occur.

We presume that you are continuing your personal work on a Chinese language translation of The URANTIA Book. As we explained, and I know you realize, URANTIA Foundation does not authorize or officially sanction your work at this time.

To avoid infringement of the copyright on The URANTIA Book, you should not permit any use of your work which could be considered publication, or would place the work in circulation, even to a limited extent. It should be held for your individual use.

Of course, it is always possible that your work would progress to completion in a refined, fully accurate state suitable for publication by or under the auspices of URANTIA Foundation, but until URANTIA Foundation gives its official sanction to the work, we ask that you not imply that your work is associated with it. The reason is that URANTIA Foundation, in an effort to preserve the integrity of its identity and that of its sister organizations, does not permit its name or marks to be used unless specific authorization is given after careful deliberation. Your efforts have not reached that state yet.

Meanwhile, we wish you well in these efforts. We know you derive considerable satisfaction yourself from this work and the sharing of it with your fiancée.
