Dear John:

The Trustees of URANTIA Foundation are pleased to grant Rocky Mountain URANTIA Society of Denver the requested permission to use the registered marks, the mark URANTIA and the Concentric-Circles Symbol, on the Bulletin for 1986-1987 of the Boulder School for Students of The URANTIA Book, which is sponsored by the Society.

A copy of the Bulletin for 1986-1987 was reviewed and it was determined that the Symbol was properly displayed and that the appropriate language indicating a grant of license for the use of the registered marks was affixed to the publication. We do request that when the word URANTIA is used in its mark sense (e.g., as part of the name of the Society or Foundation), the word should be displayed in its logotype form or in all capital letters if used in text.

This grant of permission is effective for a period of one year from the date of this letter and is limited to the Bulletin for 1986-1987 as it is presently constituted, a photocopy of which is attached.

The Trustees reserve the right to revoke this license at any time if in their discretion such use is no longer beneficial to the aims, purposes and goals as determined from time to time of, by and for URANTIA Foundation.

We ask that in the future you contact URANTIA Foundation prior to the publication of the Bulletin of the Boulder School and request permission to use the registered marks on the publication. By following this procedure, we will be able to review how the marks are displayed and correct any problems prior to the distribution of the Bulletin.


For your information, Provision 2(h) of the Licensing Agreement entered into between URANTIA Foundation and Rocky Mountain URANTIA Society of Denver reads as follows:

"To insure the observance of the provisions set out immediately above and any other requirements as may be communicated by the Foundation from time to time, the Society shall permit representatives of the Foundation to review, at all reasonable times, the nature and quality of the services and activities being performed and conducted by the Society in connection with which the Society proposes to make use or display of the word URANTIA and/or of the Symbol."

We wish to take this opportunity to alert you to the fact that as a consequence of the above provision of the Licensing Agreement, it will be necessary for URANTIA Foundation to review those services and activities of the Boulder School which are offered in connection with the licensed marks. At some point, we will contact you about this matter and will establish a time mutually acceptable for conducting such a review.
