
I receive many letters, but few as kind and touching as yours. One can well understand your concerns and reactions about litigation, especially since you have not been able to dialogue with us about those situations requiring it.

We have all entered into the work surrounding the dissemination of the teachings of The URANTIA Book with great enthusiasm and hope. Some of us have, however, done so with the realization that we live in an imperfect world and in dealing with a revelation the means and methods we can use to protect the text and our registered marks is limited both by the evolutionary development of our readership and our society. This leaves us with not always the best of situations. Nevertheless, the Trustees have undertaken the task of protecting the text of The URANTIA Book and protecting our registered marks. Often we must seek the best legal advice possible, and unfortunately, sometimes we must resort to the courts to protect our rights.

With respect to the recent C.U.B.S. litigation, we shall be providing a report to our readers in the near future. I hope it will give you some perspective on the matter and give you cause to renew your confidence in the Trustees.

In the meantime, please accept my thanks and our good wishes to you. Despite many problems which require the attention of the Trustees, solid progress is being made in carrying out our trust, especially as it relates to the spread of the teachings of The URANTIA Book. Over 200,000 copies of the book, in English and in French, have been sold or otherwise distributed, and many have rejoiced in the liberating discovery of the book's teachings. In addition, because we have protected the copyright and the registered marks "URANTIA" and the Concentric-Circles Symbol, many more sincere truth-seekers such as yourself will also have the same privilege as you and I did, in discovering and subsequently profiting from the unadulterated teachings of The URANTIA Book.
