SUGGESIIONS FOR URMNTIAN MUSIC RECORDINGS:
Gentlemen:

As you probably know I have writtion some serious "Musical Compositions" to parts of the Unantia Book, with words put to music exactly and verbatum out of the paçes of our beloved Pevelation. These include to the "Universe Preyers Suite" (pages 1620 thru 1624, you have a copy of these), 2. The "Ordinatiom Sermon" (pages 1569 IP, thru 157 J inclusive, of which a casette recording of very low quality is included and the copy of the sheetmusic herewith enclosed. 3. "At Jotapata" (pages 1638 thru 1641 incl。This is edited, rather there are some passages left out, but holds true to the way they're indited in the Book. This is still in pencil and haven't really finished them, but the structure and melodies are at hand and as soon as I go to "ink", I shall send you a copy). And 4. A yet unwritten and unplanned, except that it shall probably be Jesus" "Farwell Discourse"from pages 1944 onward.

Out of the above outlined passages and their music, I propase to produce: two Long-Playing records with Brett, Basnett; (The Gentlemen who sang them at: the OkIahoma Forum) singing, with a choir and studio orchestra, the master tapm of which I am proposing to donate to the Urantia Brotherhood for purposes saiekeoping and eventual distribution. I will be paying for the production costs myself, up to and including the finished mastemntapes from which casettes and the "Hother" for IP Albums can be produced for distibution, as damand shail warcant the supply, after arb-wosk for the albun-cover (which my wife vill be happy to do free of charge) and Iinesmotes (for which I hope to enlist the services of either Christy or one of the trustees, and I don't think they will charge too much for it) are completed.

I have had numerous requasts, from practicaliy everybody present when we perm formed the "Ordination Sermon" at the Form in Oklahoma last week, that if and when such recordings will be available, they would like to purchase same and if not, to be able to avail thanselves of the recording of what we did at the Forum in Oklahoma. I have a list of people that I have promised to let ther lnow of what and when will be availbale of this as soon as the hereby requested technicalities are ironed out.

I harreby request permission to quoto in the above described musi cal manner from the Urantia Book those passages which are thus set to music, for purposes we shall mutually decide upon in the fuxute to the ultimate good of our mutual purposes. I am fully willing to cooperate with whatever constructive suggestians you may wish me to heed to, now and ensuingly.

I wish to go on record stating, that I have no profit motives in mind, though I would appreciate consideration of placing a part of the profits to the purpose of producing further recordings of music not yot written, to be written and recorded in the future in a similar manner. I would further like to state that I do not even wish my name to appear on these recordings, setting the precedent of "service motivation" in Urantira musical endevours.

If you or the Brotherhood does not feel jourselves qualified in handing the manufacture and/or distribution of these materials, I would be willing and happy to assist and organise a comitteo who should be entrusted with this job, in a manner mutually agroeable.

Thank you very much for your kind cooperation, before closing, may I state that I have made tentative plans to do these productions October this year and will prodeed with my timetable in the spirit that your formal permission is forthcoming. Until then I remain

After I absorb production costs, the following procedure and expenses shall
approximately prevail.


Thus the first 200 pressings: (Readily distibutable double albums) shall have a cost of $\$ 563^{\circ}$ - (Give or take $\$ 50$. ) and they can be distributed at the sales price of \$ 12- per set (normal sale price for 2 albums) thereby yielding $\$ 2.400$ - in revenue inclusive of a profit of $\$ 1.832$. and for further distribution only the pressings (and jackets) would have to be paid for yielding a profit of $\$ 10.60$ per set sold. Even if you go to distributors through wholesalers you would then sell these albums for the normal wholesaleprice of $\$ 7.50$ a set, yielding a profit of $\$ 5.90$ per set, so as you can see there is quite a source of revenue here for our Bromerhood.
